Directives to the authors of reviews

Please take into account the following typographical guidelines:

1° **Title**: the author's surname in small capitals, followed by his/her bracketed first name(s); italicize the work's title; insert a period between the name, title and other elements of the reference as illustrated in the example below; if applicable, also include the (capitalized) series name and page numbers in Roman numerals. If the work was edited by one or several persons, these names are to be followed by the abbreviation « ed. » or « eds. » (or « éd. » of « éds. » if published in French).

Example: STENGERS (Jean). *Congo, mythes et réalités. Cent ans d'histoire*. Gembloux, Éditions Duculot, 1989; one vol. 16 x 24 cm, XI-345 p., ill. (DOCUMENTS HISTOIRE, vol. 4). Price: 25 €. - ISBN 2-8011-0836-7.

- 2° **Text of the review**: italicize terms in foreign languages; abbreviations and Roman numerals in small capitals (e.g.: Leopold III, NATO). Centuries are to be written in Arabic numerals, in superscript (e.g.: 17th century).
- 3° **Signature**: write your name in full, followed by your surname in small capitals; in the next line, include the italicized name of the institution you are attached to.
- 4° **Mailing of reviews**: reviews are to be emailed to one of the following e-mail addresses: <u>adierken@ulb.ac.be</u>, <u>alain.dierkens@skynet.be</u>, <u>guy.vanthemsche@vub.ac.be</u> or <u>cloir@ulb.ac.be</u>
